### To study with Q-Chat

1. [Log in](#) to your account.
2. Open a set.
3. Select Q-Chat.
4. Select the study activity you'd like to start with, or select Skip to start a general study session.
5. Select from several study activities to get started.
  1. Teach me
  2. Quiz me
  3. Apply my knowledge (available for sets in English, French, and German)
  4. Practice with sentences (available for sets using two languages)
6. Start studying!
